

## Description

BCK Programs, LLC (BCK) is an environmental education company that partners with school districts and local governments to create student-directed sustainability programs.

BCK's approach to creating school district sustainability includes collaboration with key school district staff while providing innovative educational programs with a strong student voice. With BCK guidance, students will produce recommendations to improve sustainability and pollution prevention in a broad range of environmental topics.

BCK currently works with over a dozen schools within multiple school districts and is offering paid internships to college students wishing to enter the field of sustainability and/or education.

Environmental Education interns will assist BCK instructors in the implementation of our environmental science programs on topics including waste diversion/zero waste, watershed protection, energy conservation, air pollution, water conservation, and climate action. Tasks may include the following:

### Assist with Environmental Science Lessons

- Help supervise students outside (within school campus) while conducting inspections and activities, assist students with in-class labs, assist instructors with set-up and clean-up of labs and activities.

### Assist with Waste Diversion/Zero Waste Activities

- Assist/conduct lunchtime waste audits at school campuses, assist/conduct waste diversion training for young students, help develop engaging activities to teach zero waste techniques for young students, periodic monitoring of waste stations during student lunchtime.

## Commitment

BCK holds lessons Monday-Friday in multiple school districts in North County, as well as National School District in South County. Most of the work for the internship position is anticipated in North County.

- Interns will provide their own transportation to school campuses, and be available on weekdays during school hours (8am-2:30pm), and on occasional weekends and afternoons.
- Internship schedule is flexible ranging from 5-15 hrs/wk depending on intern availability.

- Interest in the sustainability sector including environmental science, biology, ecology, environmental/civil engineering, environmental studies,
- Interest in the education sector/education studies and likes working with students ranging in age from kindergarten to high school,
- Wants to help inspire the next generation in creating a more sustainable planet.
